Ken Buck, Grundy County Veterans Commission Superintendent, is working to compile a list of veterans for the donation quilts. We will share those names as soon as names become available.

Important QOV Dates:

6/12: Deadline to advise Clara that you volunteer to make a donation quilt. Invitations and Recipient Forms will be available to guild members.

7/10: Deadline to sign up to make a quilt for a specific recipient. Clara to share recipient information for donation quilts. Completed Recipient Forms are due to Clara. A rough number head count for attendance due to Clara.

8/07: Meeting is held 1 week earlier than our regular meetings. QOV Show & Tell at our monthly meeting (please have your quilts completed by this date). Pictures of completed quilts due to Clara for presentation.

8/10: Quilts of Valor Ceremony at Saratoga Cafetorium @ 2pm.
