- How quilters can create their own and guidance on how to do it most effectively.





Turn a nice quilt into a WOW quilt by adding easy-to-piece Nickel Borders. In this lecture, we focus on easy-to-piece borders that are made from 5" squares. I will show many of my quilts that have pieced borders and walk you through my method of “auditioning” borders for a quilt.



We have all been there; the inside of the quilt top is done and now what do I do for a border. This lecture will give you many ideas to choose from and allow you to awaken a whole new level of creativity. I have loved designing pieced borders over the years and adding them to my quilts. My book, *Nickel Quilts & Borders* contains 260 pieced border ideas and I look forward to sharing many of them with you during the lecture!

I Stitch, Therefore, I Am

The life of a stitcher as told in story and song.

Discover the artist's colorful life presented with slides of her narrative quilts like "Gus Cleans His Room" and "Nude Blue Chair Reclining". Learn what drives her to create quilts about a blue chair, garden implements, and unsung appliances. Or how an obsession with hand embroidery has triggered a series of whimsical houses in unusual neighborhoods. This intriguing biographical section is followed by information about the techniques used in creating her art quilts and hand embroideries. Also, a selection of tunes from the Chicago School of Fusing Bond Fire Songbook will be sung throughout the lecture by the intrepid lecturer.



Laura Wasilowski is a textile artist creating free-form hand embroideries and improvised art quilts. Working with her hand-dyed fabrics and threads, her artwork is narrative in nature and whimsical in style expressing her joy and love of making art.

Laura's art is collected and exhibited internationally and has appeared in multiple publications since her career began in 1992. She is also the author of 5 books on creating textile art and an online instructor with Creative Spark.


Living in Elgin, Illinois, she tends her garden, cares for her family, and creates small ceramic sculptures when not stitching her colorful fabrics.
