Show Dates: Friday, October 11 and Saturday, October 12, 9am to 4pm both days Set Up Dates: Wednesday, October 9 and Thursday, October 10

### Judging:

• We are starting judging earlier than normal; all guilts will need to be dropped off by Wednesday evening at 6 p.m.

### **Entries:**

- Quilts/projects **MUST** have been completed between the last guilt show (November 2022) and this show (October 2024).
- Category info is attached; there's usually a category for almost any guilt project but let Linda know if you have questions about where your project fits.
- Linda will also have printed category sheets AND registration forms at the August meeting BUT THEY HAVE TO BE TURNED IN THAT NIGHT!!!
- Entry forms will be due by the **Aug. 8** guild meeting so that we can have the detail sheets and check-in tags for you at the **Sept. 12** guild meeting. *Thanks, Linda Charley!*

### For the Boutique:

- The committee is collecting non-quilt-shop fabric yardage, PRECUTS, panels, notions, books, patterns, and more, including handmade items, for the Boutique.
- Bring magazines for the boutique to the quilt show on Wednesday after 4pm or Thursday during setup.
- Keep gathering bags of scraps (at least 2 inches) and see someone on the committee for a bag! Boutique Comm.: Lana Stafford, Jo Snider, Patti Rosenbaum, Diane Flynn

## For the \$6-a-yard Room:

• If you have quilt-shop-quality fabric (fat quarters and yardage) you're getting rid of, consider donating it to the guild for the \$6-a-yard room. PLEASE measure and note the size on it with masking tape for Shari and team; she's gotten a lot of fabric donated already that still needs to be measured and priced. PLEASE NOTE: When measuring yardage larger than 1/4 yard (selvage to selvage), round DOWN to the nearest quarter or third yard increment-we aren't doing eighths! Room leader: Shari Rittenhouse
